7. New Business:

- a. Chiefs Induction Ceremony is 20 Jan 96; Chief Thomas briefed the group; considering having a retired Chief to be guest speaker; \$20.00 per person for buffet dinner; Chief Thomas requested a donation from Chiefs Group, but was refused; There will be 9 active duty and 5 Reserve Chiefs to be inducted; Chief Corbiser talked about trying to sign up new Chiefs at the induction to get them involved in group; Chief Lowe explained that the spouses would be given a rose (should be enough money in the \$20.00 to cover expenses); Chief Thomas made a motion to give Chiefs bust at induction instead of waiting until they retire; discussion occurred and a motion was made and seconded to remain as we are on bust (unanimous vote).
  - b. Request received for annual support for CCAF graduation; after discussion, motion made and seconded to give \$100.00; it was brought up that we need to donate to Reserve graduation also; a request was made to get a breakdown of expenses; motion was restated to give \$100.00 to active duty and \$50.00 to Reserve annually; this was seconded and voted in and will be included in budget henceforth; several members had to leave at this time and there was a complaint that everyone did not get their feelings known (4 Chiefs raised their hands that they were not in favor of this support)
  - c. Chiefs and Colonels breakfast will be 2 Jan 96, 0700 at The Club; discussion as to who is allowed to come; point was emphatic that only Chiefs that have sewn-on can be in attendance.
  - d. Chief Newberry announced the drop-in at bldg 171 at 0930, 22 Dec 95
  - e. Chief Sapp called our attention to the receipt of flags; if departing Chief is receiving a flag from their unit, the Group should not also give one; this needs to be coordinated closer.
  - f. New Chiefs were introduced; Richard Woolverton and Albert Loveless
  - g. Chief Hutchinson retirement ceremony will be on Friday, 19 Jan 96 at 1000 hours at the Wash Rack (Bldg 63); Chiefs' Flight uniform will be BDUs with BDU hat.
  - h. Chief Barnett to PCS, 8 Dec 95 to McCord.
