3. DISCUSSION:

- a. The meeting was turned over to Heritage Trust representatives who then provided information on :
1. Their new Score Card Program
 2. Money Market accounts and Certificates of Deposit
 3. New ATM locations, including the NCO Club
 4. Plans for a self-service kiosk down town near the market featuring PC software that may be made available for private use that would allow full access for remote banking.
- a. The September meeting minutes were approved as amended.
- b. The Treasurers report was not available

4. SEA TIME:

- a. Chief Draughn reported that frocking is a dead issue at AF level.
- b. He reported that we sent 17 people to the Order of the Sword Ceremony for Gen. Armstrong and it was well worth the effort and expense.
