1. Chief Thomas opened the meeting by reviewing the minutes. Some administrative corrections were made once again (get it straight secretary) and the minutes were approved by the membership.
2. Treasury report was submitted by Chief Clemons for approval. Chief Clemons amended the report by adding a cost of \$134 for a chiefs bust. Membership approved the report.
3. Chief Thomas welcomed Chief Gary Edmondson to the group.
4. Chief Thomas reiterated the importance in supporting the NCO Enhancement Workshop. He has the schedule of the next couple of class. The workshop may expand from 3 to 5 days in the future. Chief Sapp, Brock and Woolverton have volunteered to be instructors for the NCOEW. We need more Chiefs to teach the younger troops.
5. A Chief's roster will be developed including active duty and Reserve ; POC is Chief Thomas.
6. We are going to need 8 people minimum , a gas grill, a generator and \$120 to start up and run a booth at this years Air Expo. Chief Clemons is the POC. We need a volunteer to be our Air Expo logistics person (needs to be good at "procuring things") and be at the next Air Expo meeting (4 Sep 1030, community center.
7. SEA SPEAKS or is that Barks:
 - The Wing King has stated that weeds and tall grass have no place at Charleston.
 - Enlisted Club membership is at a dismal 30 %. We need to find out some of the Whys from our folks.
 - EPRs- If a person enters the weight management program, a statement needs to be place in the raters block of the report which covers that period. If the individual is still in the program and is performing

satisfactorily the next reporting period a statement is not needed however a positive statement may be added.

-Chiefs need to be involved in the Top - 3. Attendance at the last meeting was a all time low.

-Three recommendation were put forward to the floor to improve the current promotion ceremonies.

-- Develop annual SNCO induction ceremony, inducting TSgt to MSgts.

-- Create an annual NCO induction ceremony for SRA to SSgt

--Establish a monthly pin-on ceremony for all enlisted

8. Chief Maldin made a motion to have the Chief's Group take on the task of creating an annual SNCO induction ceremony. The motion was seconded. Motion was voted in.

9. Chief Clemons alerted the membership of the approaching Chief Induction ceremony. He gave out two possible dates; 11 Jan/17 Jan.

10. Old Business

-The Enlisted Heritage Hall at Gunter AFB currently show cases the names of groups who donate \$250 or more at a whack. Chief Clemons will work the issue of getting our groups name up on the wall as we donate \$100 a month throughout the year. **CMSgt Clemons told us we are out of luck. The Enlisted Heritage Hall will not add our name to the wall until we donate a minimum of \$250 at one time, end of discussion. The Group needs to make a decision on this before any more money is disbursed.**

■ Chief Monroe volunteered to make some calls to find a better Chief Bust. **Still in work, will brief at the next meeting. OPEN**
