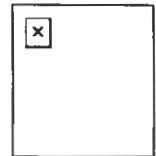




# Charleston Chiefs' Group

## Minutes for 20 May 2004

**SUBJECT:** MEETING MINUTES – 20 May 2004

**1. ATTENDANCE: 17 Chiefs and 6 Visitors**

2. The meeting was opened with the introduction of Ms. Tina Doscher from Heritage Trust Federal Credit Union. Tina discussed issues concerning available assistance on owning a home and opening Christmas Club accounts. Mr. Quince Cody spoke on identity theft and the opening of the Dorchester Road Branch by the end of the year.
